A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

This Institution – Sri Akilandeswari Women’s College, then affiliated to Madras University was established in the year 1995 by Swamy Abedhanandha Educational Trust, Wandiwash which was established in accordance with the wishes of Pujoyashri Swamiji Abedhanandha Saraswathi. At present the college is affiliated to Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore .

The college is named after the presiding deity of Thellar Village where the Institution initially functioned.

The late Swamiji had a lofty vision of uplifting the rural women from poverty and ignorance which helped in the blossoming of this only Women’s College in Thiruvannamalai District. Our College provides value based education giving emphasis on morality and discipline. This helps in producing patriotic citizens of the future, fulfilling the present need of our country.

Initially, this Institution was started with three Job – oriented Under Graduate Courses viz., Biochemistry, Microbiology and Nutrition Food Service Management and Dietetics with only 35 Students, Principal, 5 Faculty members and one office assistant. At present our Institution has grown up with 100 Faculty members, 50 Non Teaching staff and with 2500 students.

Our College is being awarded with 2(f) and 12(B) status as per the UGC Act and is permanently affiliated to Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore. We have been accredited with B+ by NAAC in 2006 and Re-accredited with **A** grade in 2016.

The college is now sprawling with elegant buildings, well equipped Library and well equipped Laboratories and with all required amenities for the students. Our Institution has steadily developed as a top most institutions of High caliber. Our aim and motive is to develop good morality and better standard in higher education. Every year a new valuable course is being added which shows our sustainable growth. At present 10 UG Courses 8 PG Courses 3 M.Phil., and 4 Ph.D., Courses(Microbiology and Biochemistry as Fulltime/ Parttime and Commerce and Tamil as Parttime) are being conducted. We are the leading Women's Institution conducting so many courses in the Thiruvalluvar University.

There are five symbols in the emblem. The Computer, Atomic Model, Microscope and wash bottle which denotes the science courses offered in the college. The earthen lamp points out Thiruvannalmalai Temple where Lord Siva manifests himself in the form of mountain, which itself is regarded as flame of fire, one of the pancha bhutas. In sense the “lamp” symbolizes; when women are educated they alight the environment, family, town, nation and the globe at large.

In the centre, we find the letters SAETW which denote the trust that runs the college namely, SWAMY ABEDHANANDHA EDUCATIONAL TRUST, WANDIWASH.

2. மாணவிகள் கல்லூரி நேரம் ஆரம்பமாவதற்கு 5 நிமிடங்கள் முன்னதாகவே கல்லூரிக்கு வரவேண்டும். முதல் மணி அடிப்பதற்குள் வகுப்பறைக்குள் இருக்கவேண்டும்.
3. விரிவுரையாளர்கள், விரிவுரையாளர் அல்லாத பணியாளர்கள் மற்றும் சக மாணவியருடன் மரியாதையுடனும், பணிவுடனும் மாணவிகள் நடந்துகொள்ள வேண்டும்.
4. மாணவிகள், கல்லூரி வளாகத்திற்குள், காணும் அனைத்துத் துறை விரிவுரையாளர்களுக்கும் வணக்கம் செலுத்த வேண்டும்.
5. மாணவிகள் கல்லூரிக்குள் கண்டிப்பாக கைபேசியை (செல்போன்) உபயோகப்படுத்தக் கூடாது.
6. வகுப்பறைக்குள் விரிவுரையாளர்கள் மற்றும் சிறப்பு விரிவுரையாளர்களின் அனுமதியின்றி வகுப்பறையை விட்டு வெளியே செல்லுதல் கூடாது.
7. வகுப்பு நேரம் முடிவடையும் முன்பு, மாணவிகள் விரிவுரையாளர்களின் அனுமதியின்றி வகுப்பறையை விட்டு வெளியே செல்லுதல் கூடாது.
8. வகுப்பு நேரத்தில் நடைபாதையில் (வராண்டா) கண்டிப்பாக நடக்கக் கூடாது. வகுப்பறைகள் மற்றும் ஆய்வகங்களில் மாணவிகள் அமைதி காக்க வேண்டும்
9. மாணவிகள் வகுப்பறையிலிருந்து வெளியேறும் போதும், ஒரு வகுப்பறையிலிருந்து மற்றொரு வகுப்பிற்குச் செல்லும் போதும் அமைதியாகவும், வரிசையாகவும் செல்ல வேண்டும்.
10. மாணவிகள் வகுப்பறையில் விரிவுரையாளர்களிடம் கட்டுப்பாட்டுடன் நடந்து கொள்ள வேண்டும். வகுப்பறைகளில் ஆசிரியர்களின் கருத்தே இறுதியானது.

11. அரசு மற்றும் உயர்கல்வித்துறை குறிப்பிட்டுள்ள நன்னடத்தை மற்றும் நல்லொழுக்கம் இல்லாத மாணவிகள் தற்காலிகமாகவோ அல்லது நிரந்தரமாகவோ கல்லூரியிலிருந்து நீக்கப்படுவர்.
12. மாணவிகள் கல்லூரியில் சகமாணவிகளின் மனம் புண்படும்படி நடந்து கொண்டால் (ராகிங் செய்தால்) அவர்கள் மேல் தக்க நடவடிக்கை எடுக்கவும், கல்லூரியை விட்டு நீக்கவும் முதல்வர் மற்றும் கல்லூரி நிர்வாகத்திற்கு முழு அதிகாரம் உண்டு.
13. கல்லூரி விதிமுறைகளை மீறும் மாணவிகளின் மேல் நடவடிக்கை எடுக்கும் போது கல்லூரி முதல்வரின் முடிவே இறுதியானது.
14. திருவள்ளூர் பல்கலைக்கழகம் மற்றும் கல்லூரி நிர்வாகத்தினரால் அவ்வப்போது உருவாக்கப்படும் விதிமுறைகளை மாணவிகள் கண்டிப்பாக கடைப்பிடிக்க வேண்டும்.
15. மாணவிகள் கல்லூரிக் கட்டணத்தை, கல்லூரி ஆண்டு தொடக்கத்தில் 50மூ-மும் மீதமுள்ள தொகையை நவம்பர் மாத இறுதிக்குள் செலுத்துதல் வேண்டும்.
16. ஒருமுறை செலுத்திய கல்லூரிக் கட்டணம், எக்காரணம் கொண்டும் திருப்பித் தரப்படமாட்டாது.
17. மாணவிகள் பெற்றோருடனோ அல்லது கல்லூரி விடுதியிலோ மட்டும் தங்க அனுமதிக்கப்படுவர். வேறு உறவினர்களுடனோ சக தோழிகளுடனோ தங்க அனுமதிக்கப்படமாட்டார்கள்.
18. கல்லூரியில் சேர்ந்தபின் கல்லூரியை விட்டு இடையில் விலக நேர்ந்தால், மூன்று வருடத்திற்குரிய கட்டணத்தை செலுத்திய பின்புதான் மாற்றுச் சான்றிதழ் வழங்கப்படும்.
19. மாணவிகள் விலையுயர்ந்த ஆபரணப் பொருட்கள் மற்றும் அதிக அளவு பணம் கொண்டு வருதல் கூடாது. தவறும் பட்சத்தில் கல்லூரி நிர்வாகம் பொறுப்பல்ல.

விடுதியின் விதிமுறைகள்

3. செல்போன், சலவைப்பெட்டி, ஒலிப்பதிவுக் கருவி, வானொலி பெட்டி, கையடக்க பாடற்கருவி போன்ற மின்சாதனப் பொருட்களுக்கு அனுமதி கிடையாது.
4. மாணவிகள் அனைவரும் மாலை 5.30 மணிமுதல் 7.40 மணிவரையிலும், இரவு 8.30 மணிமுதல் 10.00 மணிவரையிலும் படிப்பதற்குரிய நேரமாகப் பின்பற்ற வேண்டும். அந்த நேரங்களில் மற்ற மாணவியருடன் பேசுதல் கூடாது.
5. மாணவிகள் அனைவரும் உணவு அறையில் ஒழுக்கத்தைப் பின்பற்ற வேண்டும்
6. எக்காரணத்தைக் கொண்டும், விடுதி பணியாளர்களுடன் தேவையற்ற உரையாடல் கூடாது.
7. உணவை வீணாக்குதல் கூடாது.
8. ஒவ்வொரு மாதமும், உணவு கட்டணத்தை பத்தாம் தேதிக்குள் செலுத்திட வேண்டும். தவறினால் நாள் ஒன்றுக்கு ஒரு ரூபாய் அபராதம் விதிக்கப்படும்.
9. மாணவிகளுக்கு வரும் கடிதங்களும், மாணவிகள் அனுப்பும் கடிதங்களும் விடுதி காப்பாளர் பார்வையிட்ட பின்னரே ஒப்படைக்கப்படும்.
10. விடுதி மாணவிகள் எக்காரணத்தைக் கொண்டும் நாள்தோறும் கல்லூரிக்கு வந்து செல்லும் மாணவிகள் மூலம் கடிதப்போக்குவரத்து வைத்துக்கொள்ளக் கூடாது. மீறினால் கடுமையாக தண்டிக்கப்படுவார்

12. கல்லூரியால் பரிந்துரைக்கப்பட்ட விடுமுறை நாட்களில் மட்டுமே மாணவிகள் தங்கள் இல்லம் செல்ல அனுமதிக்கப்படுவர்.
13. மாணவிகள் விடுமுறைக்குத் தங்கள் பெற்றோர் ∴ பாதுகாவலருடன் மட்டுமே செல்ல அனுமதிக்கப்படுவர். பெற்றோர் ∴ பாதுகாவலர் வராவிடில் அவர்களிடமிருந்து பெற்றோர் கைப்பட எழுதிய அனுமதி கடிதம் பெற்றுச் செல்லலாம்.
14. பெற்றோர் மற்றும் உறவினர் (குழந்தைகள் ஆனாலும்) மாணவிகளின் விடுதி அறைக்குள் செல்லக்கூடாது.
15. பெற்றோர் ∴ பாதுகாவலர் தங்கள் மகளை காண்பதற்குரிய பார்வை நேரம் ஞாயிறு காலை 10.00 மணி முதல் மாலை 05.00 மணிவரை மாணவிகள் வெளியே செல்ல அனுமதி கிடையாது. வேலை நாட்களில் வேலை நேரத்தில் முதல்வர் அனுமதி பெற்ற பின் பார்க்கலாம்.
16. விடுதி மாணவிகள் வருடம் முடிந்த பின்னரே விடுதியை காலி செய்து செல்வதற்கு அனுமதிக்கப்படுவர். இடைப்பட்ட காலத்தில் விடுதியை காலி செய்வதற்கு அனுமதி கிடையாது.
17. விடுமுறை முடித்து கல்லூரி திறக்கும் நாளில் மாணவிகள் அனைவரும் தவறாமல் விடுதிக்கு வந்துவிட வேண்டும். அப்போது முந்தைய ஆண்டு விடுதிக் கட்டணம் எதுவும் நிலுவையில் இருத்தல் கூடாது. நிலுவையில் இருப்பின் அனுமதி மறுக்கப்படும். மேலும் அந்த ஆண்டுக்கு உரிய விடுதிக்கட்டணத்தை விடுமுறை முடிவதற்குள் (அதாவது விடுதியில் சேர்வதற்கு முன்பாகவே) செலுத்துதல் வேண்டும். அவ்வாறு செலுத்தியவர்களுக்கு மட்டுமே அறை எண் குசைளவ ஊழஅந குசைளவ ஞநசஎநன என்ற அடிப்படையில் ஒதுக்கப்படும்.
